Korea Trip Info - WHO

- 1. 18 students maximum. 5 chaperones
- 2. Sejong students who were here for the 2022-2023 school year and will be in **grades 10-12** for the 2023-2024 school year.
- 3. Priority will be given to grades 11 and 12 students who have NOT gone to Korea, then grade 10 students. Note: We are still trying to catch-up from students who missed the Korea trip due to COVID and I-131 application times last year. If more space is available, we will open up the trip to grade 9 students and then grade 8 students.
- 4. Students must sign the 3 strikes agreement and not violate it.
 - What counts as a strike: office referral, less than a 3 in any class.
 - Note: an out-of-school suspension is automatic disqualification from the Korea trip
- 5. Students must participate in **fundraising** efforts. Note: Korea trip cost for 2024 will be approximately \$1,200.

Korea Trip Info - HOW

- 1. US Citizens (and citizens of other countries): must have or obtain a passport
- 2. Non-Citizens of any country: Travel Document/ I-131 application
 - Needed for application: Green Card, Social Security Card, fees

- 3. There is no guarantee that you will get your travel document in time
