SCHOOL-HOME COMMUNICATION PLAN:


- I. Teacher will send Monthly Newsletter at the end of each month

- I. All students are required to complete their homework
- 2. If students do not finish their homework on time, teacher and EA will support the student during Morning Work time and after school (3:30-4:00pm).
 - a. Student must try to finish it on their own (accountability and ownership of learning)
 - b. Oops Slip will be given to the student for parents/guardians to be aware that the student did not complete homework on time.
